To find out if it's time to re-enroll:

1. Sign in to the [Microsoft Partner Portal](#).
2. Click **View Your Membership Account** at the top of the page.
3. If the drop-down message indicates that you have 90 days or fewer left in your enrollment, then it's time for you to begin the re-enrollment process. Click the *Re-enrollment* tab (in this table) for your membership level and follow the instructions.

Note: To re-enroll your organization, you must be a global program administrator. To find out if you are a global program administrator:

1. Follow steps 1 and 2 in the preceding instructions.
2. At the bottom of the drop-down message, click **Membership Center** to go to your membership account page.
3. Click the **Organizations** tab and select your organization and location from the drop-down list. The person listed as primary program contact is your organization's global program administrator.

To re-enroll as a Registered Member:

1. Sign in to the [Partner Membership Center](#).
2. Complete, update, or verify your profile information.
3. Agree to the Microsoft Partner Program terms and conditions.

As a Registered Member you can order a [Microsoft Action Pack Subscription \(MAPS\)](#), after you pass an [online training and assessment](#) with a score of 70 percent or higher. Note: The assessment requirement is suspended for renewing subscribers until late 2009.

To re-enroll as a Certified or Gold Certified Partner:

- Sign in to the [Partner Membership Center](#).
- Complete, update, or verify your profile information.
- Agree to the Microsoft Partner Program terms and conditions.

Certified Partners:

- Earn 50 qualifying [Partner Points](#). (Refer to the [Partner Points Estimator](#) to see how your organization can earn points.) Earning a [Microsoft competency](#) can help you achieve this requirement quickly.

Gold Certified Partners:

- Earn 120 qualifying Partner Points. (Refer to the [Partner Points Estimator](#) to see how your organization can earn points.)
- Earn at least one Microsoft competency.
- Ensure that your organization employs or contracts with at least two [Microsoft Certified Professionals \(MCPs\)](#) or has developed at least one certified tested solution.
- Participate in [Customer Satisfaction Index \(CSAT\)](#), which will be required by October 2009.
- Ensure that the appropriate MCPs you employ or contract with are associated with your organization and are linked to the competency and specialization you have chosen.
- If the MCPs must pass newer exams to help you stay at your current Microsoft Partner Program level, provide enough time for the MCPs to maintain their certifications without jeopardizing your re-enrollment.
- Ensure your customer references are up to date. If you have references that will soon expire, give yourself enough time to request new references and for your customers to accept them before your membership expires.
- Ensure that your references are assigned to the competency and specialization you have chosen.
- Verify that you have met any other requirements for the competency you have chosen and that your account reflects this status.
- Sign the terms and conditions.
- Pay the fee requirement for your country.

Update: Partners who re-enroll at the Gold Certified level after October 2009 must have participated in at least one [Customer Satisfaction Index](#) survey during the previous 12 months.*

*Your organization must receive 10 or more survey responses. Up to eight survey responses can be from the same customer organization.
